# 1. <u>PRESENTATION / REPORTS</u>

#### De Funk reported the following:

Copies of Child Development Program / EESD Program Self-Assessment and the Quality Counts California Rating Matrix were included in the agenda packet. The program reports were explained by De Funk, Director of Child & Family Resources. It was pointed out that there are 20 separate measures that are considered in the reviews and that all were sufficiently described and explained.

De also pointed out that there is talk of requiring additional education for ECE teachers, including the potential of requiring a BA Degree.

It was reported that De has written and is applying for a grant to fund the possible moving of Stronghold Court School to the AES site. If successful, the facility will house both of the MCOE Alturas preschools.

# **Ingrid Oliver reported the following:**

The "Transitions" for the children in the Early Head Start Program in both Alturas and Tulelake had been well attended by parents and friends.

The program has an enrollment of 101. Outreach is continuing.

An emergency grant has been written to fund the replacement of the roof of the Alturas facility.

## **Leslie Corder reported the following:**

The business office staff have been busy working on closing the books for the 2018-2019 fiscal year.

It was reported that the Governor's budget included a decrease in the PERS/STRS rates, and that it will provide a savings of approximately \$55,000 for MCOE.

#### Mike Martin reported the following:

Summer maintenance projects included the painting of the MCOE buildings and the Lew Foster building at AES; the parking lot at MCOE had been sealed; and the walkway at the back of the central office had been resurfaced.

The Professional Development / Continuous Improvement Team had been extremely busy providing trainings prior to the opening of the 2019-2020 school year. It was pointed out that 16 different trainings will be provided over a 16-day period.
