Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) is an informal method of resolving Special Education/504 concerns early by exploring options in a neutral, professional, and respectful environment.

The goal is that families and districts work together shaping mutually agreeable solutions to benefit and meet the needs of the student at the earliest opportunity possible.

A neutral facilitator guides the team, promotes open communication, understanding, and full participation to support/strengthen working collaborative relationships.

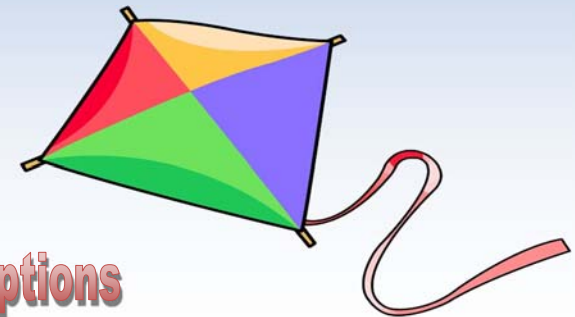
